Landscaping:

- The irrigation system is scheduled to be started up on May 15th. A map of the irrigation system (necessary for Crossroads installation) will be completed at that time.
- The landscapers broke a railing on building 1. They will pay for the damage. We have a set of railings on order as a replacement.

Grounds and Property:

• Some new plantings will be done this month in areas that are sparse.

Old Business:

• We plan to conduct some interviews for a new handyman in the next few weeks. If anyone knows of someone, please pass their information on to the board.

New Business:

- Summer Newsletter is in the works.
- The Annual Meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 29th

REMINDERS:

It's planting season. If you plan to plant:

- Perennials You must ask the Board for permission before anything is planted.
- Annuals Can be planted without permission, as long as, the plants must be
 positioned so the mature plant is a minimum of 6 inches from the edge of
 the lawn. (The mature size is noted on the tags that come with the flowers.) This
 guideline is intended to allow the landscapers to mow closer to the edge of the
 mulch bed without harming your plants. It also will reduce the use the weed
 wackers, which causes grass to be thrust into the mulch beds creating a messy
 mulch bed and increases the amount of weeds.
