- · Our annual audit is still in process.

Snow Removal:

• The ice melt spreader is being cleaned and tuned up.

Landscaping:

- The two smoke bushes behind Building 11 were removed and replaced with five arborvitae.
- Two flower pots have been placed at the mailbox area and two half-barrels have been placed at the entrance and flowers have been planted.
- The plant bed at the right end of Building 1 has been cleaned up.
- New flowers have been planted on the island in front of Unit 69.
- We are still looking at tree choices for the front of Buildings 6 and 7.
- Loam and seed have been applied to several areas on the property.

Grounds/Property:

- Remedial work has been completed on the slope behind Building 2.
- Upcoming projects waiting to be scheduled: catch basin repair in front of Unit 72, trip hazards in front of Building 2, replacement sidewalk at the mailbox area, and Building 8, 9, and 10 waste pipe cleaning.
- Our property walk and review identified several issues that we will deal with over the course of the summer.

Buildings:

- New rain handlers have been installed on the back of Buildings 1 and 2.
- Selected areas of several buildings will be power washed soon.
- We are still waiting for a part for the Unit 85-86 doorbell/intercom system.
- The front entrance doors of Building 1 need attention.
- Many of our cellar window frames need to be caulked, sanded, and repainted.
- New composite railings are being installed on the front of Building 2 this week.
- New aluminum railings were installed at Unit 37 this week.

Unit Issues:

Trustees discussed several unit issues.
